Doug Albright is the band director in the Arcanum-Butler Local School District in Arcanum, Ohio. He has held that position since 1987. He taught for two years in the Clyde-Green Springs Schools in Sandusky County prior to coming to Arcanum. Arcanum High School bands have appeared frequently at the state finals level, and high school and junior high performing groups under his direction have earned the Ohio Music Education Association's superior rating on numerous occasions.

Mr. Albright is a graduate of Greenville High School. His collegiate degrees include a Bachelor of Music from Bowling Green State University, and a Master of Education from Wright State University. He has benefitted from the mentorship and guidance of many other musicians and colleagues.

He is an active performer with the Greenville Municipal Concert Band, and is in his 22<sup>nd</sup> season serving as the associate conductor of that group. He also has performed with the Dixie Rhythm Kings and the JR Price Big Band. He is a member of the Ohio Music Education Association, and serves as an adjudicator for OMEA solo and ensemble events, as well as for band adjudicated events.

Doug and his wife Anne make their home in Arcanum. They are the parents of Mark, Matt, and Dan.
